Entry Requirements (Year 1)

(1) Applicants must satisfy **ANY** of the following requirements:

- (a) *Five (5) or more CXC, IGCSE, GCSE passes (grades 1–3/ A–C) or equivalent, including Mathematics, English and a pure science (Biology, Human and Social Biology or Chemistry); or
***See list of approved subjects below.**
- (b) Successful completion of the Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN) Certificate with five (5) years relevant experience and an examination pass in Mathematics (CXC, IGCSE, GCSE), plus a recommendation from an employer; or
- (c) College students and college graduates are encouraged to apply and are required to present a copy of their transcript.

(2) In addition, all applicants are required to satisfy **ALL** of the following requirements:

- (a) Minimum age of 17 years at time of entry into the programme;
- (b) An essay or personal statement as part of their application;
- (c) Pass two interviews scheduled by the Admissions Committee.

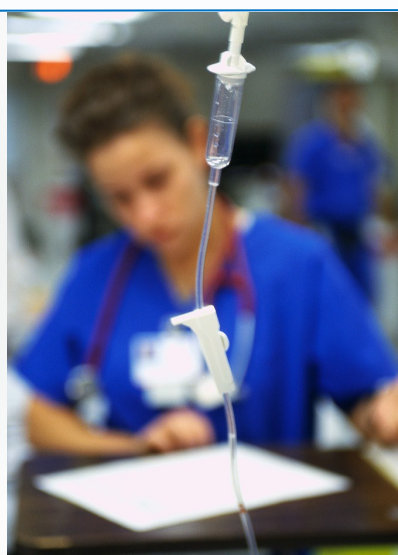
