## Admissions Requirements

(1) Applicants must satisfy any of the following requirements:

- (a) Five (5) or more CXC/IGCSE/GCSE passes (grades 1 – 3/A – C) or equivalent. Mandatory subjects: Mathematics, English and a pure science (Biology or Human and Social Biology) and the remaining two or more from the list of approved subjects below. **Only** two grades 3 or C will be accepted.  
**Or**
- (b) Successful completion of the Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN) Certificate with five (5) years relevant experience and an examination pass in Mathematics (CXC/IGCSE/GCSE or College credit), plus a recommendation from an employer;  
**Or**
- (c) College students/graduates **must** submit transcripts which will be evaluated on an individual basis.

In addition, all applicants are required to satisfy the following requirements:

- (2) *Minimum age of seventeen (17) years* at time of entry into the programme;
- (3) Submit an *essay or personal statement* as part of their application;
- (4) Pass an *interview* scheduled by the Admissions Committee
