CCNA Certification Exams

Exam Codes: 200-125 CCNA or (100-105 ICND1 & 200-105 ICND2) are the composite exams associated with the Cisco Certified Network Associate certification. Candidates can prepare for this exam by taking the **200-125 CCNA** exam or the **100-105 ICND1** and the **200-105 ICND2** exams. These exams test a candidate's knowledge and skills required to install, operate, and troubleshoot a small to medium size enterprise branch network. The topics include connecting to a WAN; implementing network security; network types; network media; routing and switching fundamentals; the TCP/IP and OSI models; IP addressing; WAN technologies; operating and configuring IOS devices; extending switched networks with VLANs; determining IP routes; managing IP traffic with access lists; establishing point-to-point connections; and establishing Frame Relay connections.
