The position covers responsibility for the strategic leadership of the Bachelor of Science in Nursing Programme at the University College of the Cayman Islands. This includes leading the development, implementation, delivery and assessment/evaluation of the programme.

Minimum Requirements:

1. A Master's degree in **Nursing Education or Nursing Administration** from an accredited university
2. A teaching certificate is required if degree is not in Nursing Education
3. Registration with or eligibility for registration with the Cayman Islands Nursing & Midwifery Council.
4. Excellent oral and written communication skills
5. Must have at least **5 years' experience of teaching in nursing with a minimum of 3 years' experience in leadership**
6. A track record in the maintenance of academic and professional excellence
7. Must be able to drive and obtain a Caymanian Driver's Licence within 30 days of employment
8. Ability to work as part of a team
9. Ability to work independently and use initiative
10. Computer literacy – strong knowledge of Word, Excel and other Microsoft Office applications
11. Excellent research and analytical skills
12. Ability to multi-task, whilst working with deadlines

Accountabilities

The Director's role is to professionally manage the learning process and to advise students in achieving and establishing learning objectives in accordance with their goals. The Director is to make use of all available resources, methods, techniques and strategies, to ensure student success. The candidate is expected to work collaboratively with colleagues to create a learning environment, which is pedagogically sound, technically supported and innovative in nature. The successful applicant will be required to teach at the bachelor degree level.

Applications

Applications must include (1) cover letter with description of experience relevant to the position, (2) curriculum vitae, (3) three references including your immediate supervisor, (4) copies of transcripts (*official transcripts will be required if offer is made*), and (5) a one-page statement of project, teaching interests and experience. Application deadline is **October 9, 2017**.
